1. Introduction - Campground Etiquette

- Read the rules/regulations for the campground/park where you are staying. Follow those first and foremost, if quiet hours are at 10P to 7A, follow them.
- Alcohol & Drugs: No public intoxication; no drug use; alcohol only allowed on your site; no profanity.
- Attire: Appropriate dress at all times.
